What do I need to bring?

Please bring the completed order requisition from your doctor, and your insurance card(s).

Do I need to fast before going to the lab?

If you have a Lipid panel, Cholesterol, Triglyceride or Glucose test you must fast. Please confirm the need for fasting with your provider if you have questions.

What is fasting?

Fasting requires that you do NOT eat or drink anything 10-12 hours before your lab test. A small amount (up to 8oz) of water, black coffee and/or tea are okay.

Specialty Kit Instructions

Specific questions regarding the kits should be directed to your provider's office. **Most kits are processed at the lab Monday-Thursday until 4pm.** Please complete all paperwork and be sure to read the kit instructions thoroughly **prior** to going to the lab.
